This event is designed to be a “personal best” activity, not a competition between students. Students are encouraged to support each other and study together as often as possible.

How it will work ~ before the event:

This is a voluntary activity! Students only participate if they want to become better spellers while having a lot of fun! Students who want to enter the contest will fill out a sign~up sheet and submit it to their instructor.

In the following day or two, the instructor will provide the student with a list of 30 words (at the student’s current level of functioning) plus a list of 5 challenge words (a grade or two above the student’s level of functioning.) The student will take the lists and spend time studying, both in and out of the classroom. Students should know the definition of each of their words and be able to use each word in a sentence.
